The Workshop Session of the Satsuma City Council

The City Council of the City of Satsuma, Alabama, convened in a workshop session at City Hall in said city at 5:30 P.M. on the 10th day of April, 2017.

The following members were present: Mayor Williams; Councilmembers: Randy Little, Mike Butler, Jason Skelton, Allison Cross and Bill Black.

Bill Black opened the meeting the prayer.

Mayor Williams stated that the first item on the agenda was the presentation of the FY2016 audit. He then turned the meeting over to Will Betancourt. Mr. Betancourt discussed the audit.

Councilmember Skelton left the meeting at 6:30 p.m.

Mayor and Council reviewed and discussed the following:

- Report on six (6) month financial status – revenues, projected revenues, expenditures and accounts balances.
- Police Officer vacancy- Mayor Williams reported that he has interviewed a potential employee for a police officer position. He stated that candidate, Gerald Roberts, has passed the background check. Mayor Williams stated that there is a need to expedite the process since there is a police academy in Selma in May. If the candidate can attend this class then the room and board are covered. He asked for a consensus to move forward and with an understanding that the hiring could be ratified at the next council meeting.
- Public Safety Building- Mayor Williams discussed his meeting with representatives of Union Bank regarding a USDA loan , additional revenue needed and revising the plans to reduce the size and cost of the building.
- Salaries- Mayor Williams discussed increasing salaries for recruitment and retention of employees.
