The Workshop Session of the Satsuma City Council

The City Council of the City of Satsuma, Alabama, convened in a workshop session at Satsuma City Hall in said city at 7:00 P.M. on the 12th day of May, 2011.

Mayor Stewart stated that the purpose of the workshop was to discuss the process in evaluating the 21 candidates which have applied for the new Satsuma City School Board. He stated that during the process he has made a statement that he thought the applications should be reviewed by an independent group outside the city. However he would like now to recommend to Council that all 21 applicants be given the opportunity for an interview before Council. He suggested that each applicant be given a list of questions can come before Council to answer those questions. At that time each Council Member will evaluate the answers. The tally will be given to the clerk to compile a list of the top 10 or so based on the total score. Council agreed with process
